Framework Partnership Agreement

BETWEEN :

- **The NGO Europa – Regular University Conferences for Public Administration in Europe:** created with the aim of actively contributing to the strengthening of the public good in Europe, EUROPA works at the intersection of research, public action, and citizen engagement. Its activities are fully aligned with contemporary dynamics of reflection and innovation in public administration, governance, public management, and public policy.

It was decided to conclude this framework partnership agreement **in order to strengthen synergies between the two parties, academic actors and organizations committed to serving the public good in Europe.**

Article 1 : Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this framework partnership agreement is, firstly, to **create and disseminate knowledge in the interdisciplinary fields of public administration** . Secondly, it aims to promote the organization of **high-level conferences and forums for exchange.**

Article 2 : Areas of Cooperation

This framework partnership agreement should facilitate and enable actions in the following areas:

- Promoting democracy in Europe
- Modernization of public action,
- Exchange of practices and comparative analyses
- Organization of conferences or webinars.
- Scientific or technical publications

Article 3 : Implementation Procedures

Each specific project may be subject to a separate implementation agreement or amendment.

Article 4 : Communication and Visibility


Each party must obtain the other's written consent before any publication using its brand image and logo.

The work and productions carried out jointly within the framework of this partnership agreement will have shared ownership and a reciprocal license to use.


